On April 14, Courtney was taken to her Doctor after experiencing horrible leg cramps at a soccer tournament. Within hours of returning home, her doctor called saying she was to go immediately to Children's hospital. After many tests, and blood transfusions, Courtney was diagnosis with AML, a rare type of Leukemia.

Courtney is in the hospital and is expected to remain there for 1 month as long as everything goes well she will get to go home for 5 to 10 days before she starts this pattern again 2 more times.
