

2010 FALL BALL RECREATIONAL SEASON

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT FALL SEASON TEAMS

1. **What is the Fall Recreational Season?** The fall season is designed for girls aged 6 -14 that want to play softball while continuing to develop their skills.
2. **When does the Fall Season start?** The fall season runs from the first weekend after Labor Day until the Sunday before Thanksgiving. Teams are formed by the Manager and team practices may begin no sooner than the first weekend in August.
3. **What days are games scheduled?** This year, there are two options:
 - o **Sundays** Clairemont Girls Fast Pitch ASA. Some games may be schedule on Saturday. (We will use East Clairemont Athlete Fields, Serra Mesa Fields and Peninsula Fields)
 - o **Saturday or Sundays** Girls Softball Federation (GSF) games at various locations in South County
4. **How are teams formed?** Each league approved team managers, sets the criteria for participation and chooses one of the above Fall Ball leagues too play at. Typically each team will have 11 or 12 girls on the roster. Players that are not ASA registered will be required to submit a registration form and a \$10.00 registration fee.
5. **How are managers approved?** Managers need to be approved by the CGFP Board of Directors. Board of Directors will hold a meeting (date to be TBD). One of the requirements will be that all Managers and other approved adult staff of 2010 Spring Season teams and 2010 All Stars teams must be in good standing with CGFP league.
6. **Why do managers need to be approved?** Only approved managers will be allowed uses of CGFP equipment and facilities. Approved managers will also have priority in scheduling field locations for practices.
7. **How much does it cost?** Each team sets and manages its own budget and expenses. Typically, the cost of uniforms, umpire fees, registration fees, game and practice balls and other related expenses is approximately \$100.00 to \$150.00 per player.
